Hole #14 Left Greenside Bunker

The Fazio design team has added more fingers in our large steep faced bunkers. This will help greatly with drainage and washing as well as add a safe way in and out of these bunkers.



Hole #18 Right Fairway Bunker

Over time, some of our bunkers have changed in size and shape due to weather and daily maintenance routines. Here on #18 the McDonald and Sons crew is bringing this right fairway bunker back to life by eliminating the first 20 yards, tightening up the edges and adding proper drainage.



Hole #18 Left Fairway Bunker

Many of our large fairway bunkers and waste areas have become very difficult to maintain. The Fazio Design team has divided many of these areas into smaller separate bunkers and/or shrunk their size entirely. The look is very appealing and the reduction of required maintenance is welcomed.



Hole #15 Greenside Bunker

This McDonald and Sons machine operator roughs up the face of the bunker prior to applying and compacting the bunker sand. This process helps the sand adhere to the steep face and not wash during a heavy rainfall.
